Where is Winters?

- 15 miles West of Davis
- 25 miles West of Sacramento
- 70 miles North of San Francisco
- 150 Miles South of Redding

How to get to Winters

FROM SAN FRANCISCO AREA

Interstate 80 east to I-505 North Exit (Winters - Redding); Proceed Northbound on 505 to the Winters Exit; Take this exit and turn left over the overpass. Go straight through the flashing red light (approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile) to Main Street. Go left at Main Street to the corner of Main and Cody Streets you will find the parade sign-in here!

FROM THE SACRAMENTO AREA

Interstate 80 to Highway 113 (Woodland) Exit. Go Northbound on 113 to Covell Boulevard Exit (1 to 2 miles from I 80). Turn left at Covell Boulevard and continue straight for approximately 15 miles to Winters. Follow the above directions to the Sign-in Table.

FROM REDDING/ NORTH STATE

Take Interstate 5 to Interstate 505 (Winters-San Francisco) Exit; Proceed to the Winters Exit. Turn right and follow the above directions to the Sign-in Table.

The Youth Day Committee would prefer that entrants park their vehicles in the lot at Main and Cody Streets and on any other side streets other than Main Street. **Absolutely no candy may be thrown by the entrants;** violators will be removed from the Parade. Horse Pre-Judging will take place on Cody Street. **NO loud music in horse areas.** There is only a 2-block distance from the horse judging area to the line-up area on 4th and Main Streets. Thank you
